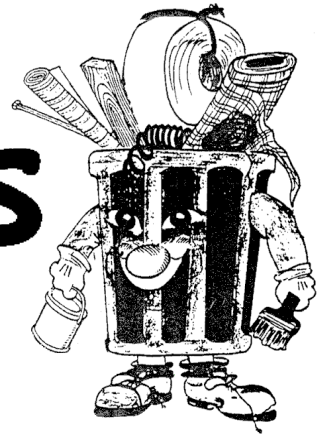

The object may have a practical use like a plastic scoop for bird food or may be a fantastical creation for example a robot .

You can make your plastic bottle object either on your own or as a group with others from your school or club.

After completion of your entry the items should be brought to Scrappies, in Church Stretton, no later than **Saturday July 18th, 2009**. Items will then be photographed and exhibited on display boards within the store.

A small booklet will be compiled showing illustrations and giving instructions for making selected items. This will be on sale at our Open Day on Wednesday August 19th, 2009. Should you wish your entry to be considered for inclusion in our booklet, please include the instructions of how to make the object with your entry.

Items which are too big to be brought into the store can be photographed and the photo then submitted for judging.

Judging by a pre-selected panel will take place at Scrappies, the judges decision is final.

Prizes will be awarded to the best in each category, and the most unusual and most useful over all categories

Presentation of prizes will be **at 2:00 pm on Wednesday August 19th in the store during the open day.**

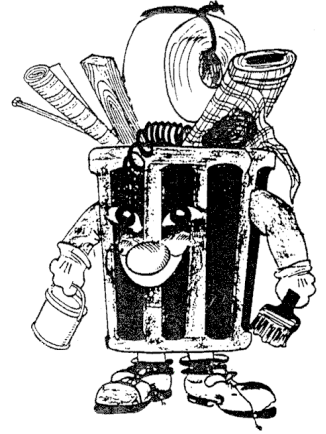
